- The Director of Coaching must have a minimum qualification of Level II, preferably Level III. A good knowledge of the sport and core skills, attend VE workshops. First Aid, Safe Guarding, CRB/DBS and be registered with Volleyball England.
- The period of appointment shall be for 2 years with an annual review

MAIN DUTIES

1. Responsibly for delivering and developing the Coaching Program for the SWVA Junior Squads for the Inter Regional Championships event on behalf of the SWVA Exec.
2. Develop a SWVA IRC Training Philosophy, Cultivate a "Love of the Game" and Provide Consistency across the four squads. Become the Face and Voice of the SWVA IRC Training Program.
3. Recruit & Interview Head and Assistant Coaches and other team staff members as required with the assistance of the SWVA Exec.
4. Liaison with County and Regional Associations/Leagues, Volleyball England and other VE junior programs as required.
5. To provide mentoring opportunities to other coaches within the organisation in order to develop coach skills and performance.
6. To encourage and promote active participation of other coaches, clubs, school, local associations, in regional training sessions.
7. To attend and provide reports for the SWVA Committee meetings.
8. To offer feedback and to provide a written report and squad photos to the SW Regional Committee on the degree of success of squad coaching and competitions.
9. Oversee that all sessions are run as part of the SW Junior VC and all SWVA web site squad training information is correct.

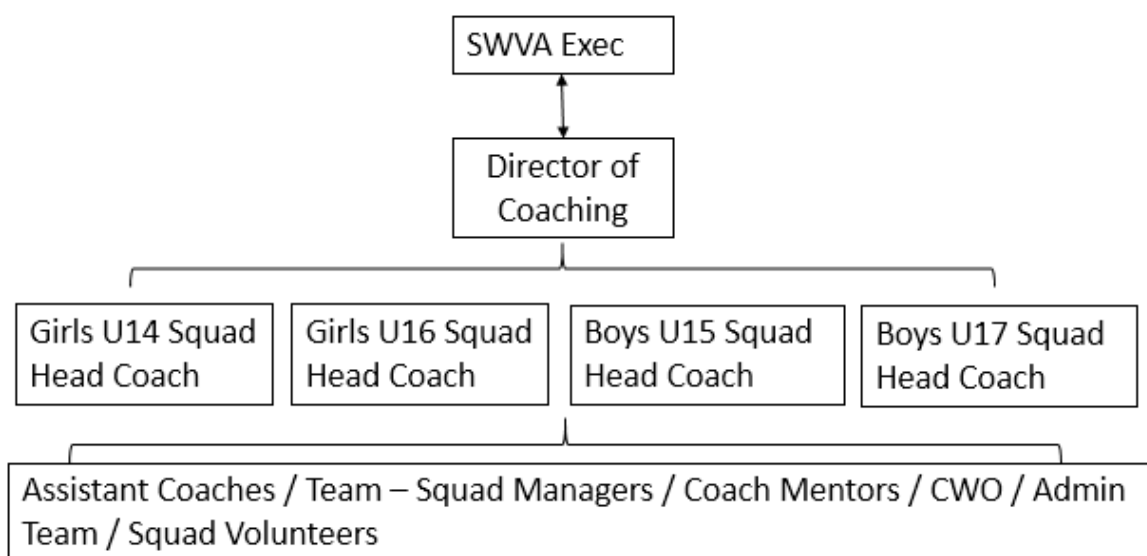

 11. To ensure the training sessions abide by the VE Codes of Conduct relating to young players and that the staff and volunteers work within the guidelines laid down by the VE Child Protection policy.
 12. To maintain a detailed record of expenses incurred in performance of regional duties.
