
I trust all our beach layers have been glued to the BBC iPlayer this week and enjoying the Commonwealth Games matches.


Junior Commonwealth Cup 2022

Referee Level 4 Course in Bristol



Hello all, My name is Ignacio Díez (although you probably know me as Nacho). I'm a qualified NVL Referee and play for City of Bristol in the South West league.

There is the possibility of organising a Referee Level 4 Course in Bristol on the 17th of September, and I was wondering if your teams would be interested in sending someone. Getting people qualified to officiate would help improve the level of refereeing in the region, both in the Local Leagues and in the South West league.

Also, if there are any teams in your area who play in the National League, could you pass them this information please? Maybe they will be interested.

Some information you may want to know:

- the cost is £70 per learner (as of 1st of August).
- the course is 8 hours, typically from 9.00-17.00, on a Saturday. This is split into 4 hours in a sports hall in the morning and 4 hours in a classroom in the afternoon.
- The course is fully in person
- Learners must be at least 16 years old on the day of the course.

I hope you find this interesting and we can get some more referees in the circuit.

The End of Clifton Hill SC



The bulldozers have finally moved into the Clifton Hill Sports Centre this week, not a venue we have used recently but it was the first public sports centre built and opened in Exeter in 1985.

A group of outdoor volleyball enthusiasts from the Exeter Coaver VC booked out the whole sports hall on Friday evenings and started the Clifton Hill VC.

A few years later we changed our name to the Exeter VC & combined with the Torbay VC, forming the Exeter & Torbay VC, better known to everyone as Torexe (we didn't like ExeTor).

We have since moved on to the double court Exeter Riverside LC, almost 40 years later, the four hour Friday evening booking is still going strong and the back bone of the club's activities.



As for the Riverside LC, it's currently closed and getting a new roof and solar panels. So hopefully we will see less rain and pidgeon stuff on court next season and back open in time for the 2022/23 volleyball season.
